SMOKE DETECTOR CERTIFICATE ORDINANCE NO. 2006-19 C.O. DETECTOR CERTIFICATE ORDINANCE NO. 2016-01

Between January 1 and January 31 each year, the owner of each dwelling unit and mobile home in which a smoke and C.O. detector has been installed shall certify in writing on forms prescribed by the Town to the Fire Inspection Division of the Porter Fire Department that the required maintenance has been performed on all detectors in the owner's units, that the detectors are in good working condition in the owner's units, and that the detectors are in good working condition as of the date of certification. Each owner shall certify to each new occupancy on any dwelling unit and mobile home covered by this ordinance, that all smoke and C.O. detectors required have been installed and are in proper working condition.
