SPECIAL MEETING

SEPTEMBER 17, 2005

Vice President Sandi Snyder called the meeting to order at 7:02 pm by opening with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Present were Council members Jennifer Granat, Sandy Boothe and Paul Childress.

Snyder asked for a motion to approve the 2006 budget. Granat made the motion to approve the 2006 budget as advertised and Boothe made the second. Childress asked if he wanted to vote against the MVH form 1 budget estimates does he have to vote no for the entire budget. He was told yes. Childress explained that he does not approve making a line item # 362 for repairs to equipment for police. Granat commented that a new law was passed that the MVH could give 10% to the Police Dept. The Police Department wasn't appropriated enough money at the beginning of the year for insurance, plus the department has had unexpected car problems. Granat has advised Chief Spanier to use this money sparingly and more or less is a safety net. Next year this line item may not be used.

Snyder asked for a vote, Childress no, Granat, Boothe and Snyder yes. Vote 3-1.

Pomeroy told the Council that the Clerk's office will be closed Wednesday, September 21, because of computer training.

Childress made the motion to adjourn at 7:17 pm with Granat making the second. Vote 4-0.
