**President Jennifer Granat called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present were: Vice-President William Sexton, Sandi Snyder, Paul Childress, Sandy Snyder, Clerk-Treasurer Carol Pomeroy, Atty. Dave Hollenbeck and Police Chief.**

**Grant explained the purpose for the meeting was to pass by second and third reading Ordinance 2004-07 setting restriction on alcoholic beverage use on town property. Hollenbeck said there were two changes – references to park buildings had been eliminated and penalties added.**

**Childress read the portion carrying the amount of penalty for said infractions; the amended ordinance with a \$500.00 for the first offense, \$1,000.00 for the second and \$2,500.00 for the third and each subsequent offense. Sexton made a motion to amend the original ordinance and accept with the changes. Childress seconded. Motion carried 5-0.**

**Childress made a motion to have the second and third reading by title only and for adoption of 2004-07. Boothe seconded. Motion carried 5-0.**

**Atty. Hollenbeck said he would handle the publishing of the ordinance.**

**Childress moved to adjourn with Boothe making the second. Meeting adjourned at 6:08 p.m.**
